Who We Are

Nigerians United Against Malaria, Typhoid, and other diseases is a project of Operation Peace of Mind (OPM), a nonprofit organization based in the United States of America. We have offices in Nigeria where our sister organization, Operation Peace of Mind Foundation, is based. The quest to find solutions to stop the devastating scourge of these diseases precipitated the founders to lead the effort against malaria, typhoid, and other diseases.

Our Goal

Utilizing our popular LINK Program in the USA, Nigerians United Against Malaria and Typhoid (NUAMT) deploys our well-trained personnel to effectively monitor mosquito breeding areas and apply the most effective products made in the United States to eliminate the eggs by preventing the four stages of mosquito metamorphosis: eggs, larva, pupa, and adult (Males live for 6-7 days and up to several weeks in most cases— Females live 1-2 months and as long as 6 months in cold weather). We can eradicate malaria in our generation. We create employment, train, and empower entrepreneurs.

What We Do

EDUCATE: When people are educated, they can effectively contribute to their families and communities, thus creating a stable and stimulating society. Education brings skills, knowledge, and basic understanding of life. Education helps citizens learn how to work independently and with others for the community benefit. NUAMT's educational programs puts an emphasis on the effective application of preventing individuals from contracting a disease, as well as treatment for a disease.



ADOPT-A-FAMILY PROGRAM: The program offers our donors the opportunity to make a donation specifically to a family or families to be protected from malaria and typhoid diseases.

It allows the donor to monitor the effectiveness of our project. Through the Adopt-A-Family Program, the community can work together to help positively impact families in need.

PREVENTION: The proverbial statement that "an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure" makes sense. It is common sense to stop a bad incident or illness from happening than spending more resources to deal with the preventable issue. The mortality rate of Nigerians that are related to malaria/typhoid is frightening, especially in regards to the vulnerable. This is not a fight that should be left to the government alone. Citizens should take the issue of living longer as a priority.

DETECTION / INSPECTION: We believe that if one cannot prevent, then you must detect in order to assist in malaria eradication. Our trained inspectors will assist communities in surveying areas for the presence of adults and larva eggs.

Do It Yourself - Urine Malaria Test (UMT) - Our organization is partnering with a United States-based company, Fyodor Biotechnologies, Inc., which developed a product for individuals to test for malaria at home. It requires no blood, no reagents, no invasive equipment, and detects malaria through urine within 25 minutes.



TREATMENT: NUAMT discourages individuals from self-medication. Some of the risks associated with this practice are dangerous drug interactions, incorrect dosages, risk of abuse, and dependence, among others. Our organization has developed a sophisticated referral program with qualified medical doctors, hospitals, and clinics to be deployed in every Nigerian ward. The referral is free and has tremendous cost savings.



<u>DATA COLLECTION:</u> Nigeria lacks adequate data integrity. By having reliable data collection processes, our government and organizations can effectively have a deeper understanding on how to fight malaria, typhoid, and other disease outbreaks. Data assist in analyzing the allocation of resources and the general state of affairs. NUAMT will share data collected with local, state, and federal government agencies and other interested organizations.

<u>ADVOCACY AND MEMBERSHIP:</u> We continually encourage public, private, community, and faith-based leaders to be involved in our efforts. We meet with members of the legislature and executive body of each level of government for support and more funding in the healthcare sector. We mobilize and train members to be a part of this movement. Membership is free and has some benefits.

OPM works together with experts from around the world in all fields to help develop safer, more vibrant communities.
